CURRENT SITUATION

Crews will continue to work to reinforce containment lines and fire suppression repair teams remain active throughout the area. Red flag warning in effect for the area with a prediction of strong winds through this evening. **Unburned islands within the Walbridge containment lines became active with the predicted winds, resulting in a small spot fire outside the containment lines resulting in evacuations orders and warnings.**

The Hennessey Fire is currently 317,909 acres and 91% contained, the Walbridge Fire is currently 54,940 acres and 95% contained and the Meyers Fire is 2,360 acres and 100% contained.
